Store Steers to £2040 Store Heifers to £1590

Bigger numbers now coming forward as we enter the month of August with well over three hundred stores penned and sold when a tremendous quality line up of well summered cattle sold to the exceptional trade we are all enjoying at this time. Steers topped at a mighty £2040 given for an aged Limousin from Philip Glanville of Okehampton whilst the better of an outstanding run of young Limousin bullocks (16m) rose to a creditable £1680 for Roger Williams up from Penryn. Smart, later born (14m) Limousins from John Hull of Tiverton sold well and to a top of £1360 for a pen of three. Aberdeen Angus steers next in line with a couple (26m) from John Hallett in from Ottery st Mary easing to £1530 apiece with a bunch of four (25m) close at £1510 each for Duncan Parris and Family of Yarcombe. Further young store steers of high order from John Hull saw a trio of Simmental's (15m) easily draw £1470 apiece with others holding the same comments but off Dartmoor seeing a pair make £1210 a life for Mark Jones of Widecombe in the Moor. JP Matthews and Son, Torpoint brought a trailer load of their usual high class South Devon cattle which ran to £1450 for a bunch of five steers (18m) whilst John Jordan and Family in from Gidleigh saw their best South Devon rise to £1320. Groups of well grown and fed British Blue bullocks (22m) from Trevor Daniel of Chawleigh looked to be well sold when reaching £1440 and £1420 as did a couple of Blues (18m) from Martin Pratt and Family in from Honiton at £1380, also, a well farmed single British Blue (23m) from young lack Bond of Blackawton drew a creditable £1240. Eye catching Salers steers (15m) from John Jordan and Family came back at £1400 for a pair and Friesians (28m) saw £1245 for John Hull. Two standout British Blondes (24m) from Roger Oliver, Lower Ashton topped the heifer prices when drawing £1590 apiece followed by more of those top notch Limousins from Roger Williams when the best of his heifers saw one (16m) with great potential rise to £1440. Other Limousin heifer prices of note included a pair of decent sorts (25m) from Ed Pincombe of Chulmleigh that sold for £1250 each. John Hull sold a solitary Aberdeen Angus female (27m) for £1440 whilst a pen of four striking young (15m) Simmental heifers off the same farm hit £1360 each. Martin Pratt and Family back when selling their strong British Blues heifers (20m) to £1320 followed closely by South Devons (24m) from the Sleep Family of Blackawton at £1290 and Herefords (24m) from Ivor Pellow of Sourton ran to £1255. Charolais heifers (27m) saw Roger Oliver parting with a single for £1180 and smart Devon bred females (20m) from Roger and James Mugford of Diptford eased to £1090. Cows with calves at foot saw a sweet Limousin accompanied by her young bull calf fetch £1550 for Philip Glanville and the better of the small entry of grazing cows saw £1290 for a shapely South Devon from Trevor Adcock of Moretonhampstead.

A decent entry of calves saw another excellent trade for the quality forward! Top of the day was £410 for a smart young British Blue bull from Messrs LT Foale & Son of Kingsbridge who sold another at £345. Other

Simmental bulls to £310 & £300 x 4 for Keith & Shirley Wotton of Dartmouth. Best of the native calves topped at £310 for a South Devon bull from Messrs JP Matthews & Son of Torpoint. 761 STORE LAMBS/HOGGS

A great day in the sheep pens with a real buzz in all sections and corners of the market. The day started with the weekly entry of nearly 800 store lambs which sold to a very similar trade overall to give an average of £99 overall, within a pound of last week's average. Topping the trade was Phillip Glanville of Exbourne with sizable lambs followed by D Wills of Axminster with Dutch Spotted at £128, Archie Hill of Shepton Mallet with Beltex at £127 and John Midgley of Bovey Tracey sold his first two pens of Suffolk x Mule ewe lambs at £120 apiece. Plenty of forward but not fit lambs selling from £105 to £118 and the better bred mediums were either side of £100. Smaller, younger or indifferently bred sorts back from that but usually all top side of £60.

46 GRAZING EWES & RAMS & 9 BREEDING EWES

Numbers remaining tight with WA Williams of Helston topping the sale with a pair of Suffolk crosses at £151 followed by Richard and Angela Smaridge of East Allington with a ram at £116 and Colin Nankervis up from St lves sold Cheviot ewes to £110 & £93. Genuine lean ewes either side of £100 and goats to £81 for David Stephens of Liskeard. Paul Walton of Teignmouth sold the only pen of breeders in the commercial section, being Texel x Mule shearlings selling well at £170.

37 DEVON & CORNWALL LONGWOOL EWES & 24 RAMS

This years first seasons show and sale of Longwools included the Yeatheridge flock dispersal on behalf of Geoff & Liz Hosegood of East Worlington which saw their best pairs of breeders sheep sell at 350gns twice whilst their penfuls of flock aged ewes sold at 160gns twice, 150gns and 120gns. Julie Lukehusrt travelled down from Kent to sell her best shearlings at 220gns and 200gns and Graham & Daphne Tucker of Launceston sold a trio at 200gns.

The rams were a selective trade with only 50% clearance, that said the best were competitively bid for with a top of 950gns given the pick of the pen from JG & SJ Tancock of Callington who sold another at 500gns, a price matched by Graham & Daphne Tucker. Edward Darke & family of Chillington reached 480gns as well as exhibiting the overall champion on the day which sold at 400gns to the Judge, Jeremy Oatey of Torpoint. Matt & Sadie Darke then followed their family members with their ram achieving 350gns and three further vendors sold rams at 300gns.

HORNACOTT DISPERSAL OF 147 PEDIGREE TEXEL SHEEP

A massive crowd descended on the sheep pens today with buyers travelling from as far afield as Glenluce in Scotland, Essex, South Wales and all corners of the Westcountry to support this rare opportunity dispersal sale on behalf of Phil & Lesley Martyn-Uglow of Launceston. These tremendously genuine sheep had just been announced South West flock competition winners, for the third time in four years, with judges Jim & Nicky Hartright congratulating the pair on such a strong, consistently classy flock.

This was evident for all to see when they were penned pre-sale and many people remarked on the quality and depth of breeding presented for sale. Trade was strong from start to finish with every sheep keenly contested, either by ringside bidding or by an eager audience of happy tappers on Marteye.

Amongst the 57 flock aged ewes two 4T aged ewes lots 42 and 45, peaked at 1700gns with the 6T ewe lot 26 following closely at 1500gns, another 4T lot 54 made 1450gns and no less than another three aged ewes sold at 1400gns to leave all 57 ewes, including a couple of milk one siders to average £855 overall.

The shearling ewes peaked at 1400gns for lot 59 with another two at 1200gns and another two at 1100gns to level at £778 for all 49 shearlings on offer. The ewe lambs provided the top price female of the day with the first of these, lot 106 a Duhonw F-Type sired lamb out of a Beautry Achilles sired ewe, she made 2000gns selling to the Davis family of Burlescombe for their Canalside flock. The majority of these 22 ewe lambs traded 450 to 700gns to level at £836.

Onto the rams and the much admired homebred stock ram Hornacott EType, by the Beautry Achilles sire, this 2021 born tup had bidders on Marteye, on telephones and finally sold ringside at 5000gns to Richard and Ian Rottenbury of Chipstable. The other stock ram made 1500gns, best of the 6 shearlings sold at 1300gns, 1000gns and 900gns three times whilst ram lambs sold to 1100gns, 1000gns and the 11 sold averaged £665.

A tremendous sale averaging £824 per head across all 147 forward and sold. Our thanks to all of the buyers, bidders and onlookers who gave the Martyn-Uglow family the trade they deserved and a fitting send off from the breed, we thank Phil & Lesley for their kind instructions and wish them well in the future.
