Prime Cattle to 335ppk & £2209 Cull Cows to 235ppk & £1748

Bigger numbers now returning as we move away from the festive period with as strong a trade as we have seen for prime cattle in our twelve years here at Exeter. It started with a top per kilo of 335pence given for a well turned out 592kg red Limousin heifer from Adrian and Bradley Bowden, Drewsteignton which realised £1980. Several other quality finished heifers on offer this week which included a well fed British Blue from Tom Yandle in from Oxton at £2012 (628kg x 321ppk) and Herefords reaching £1873 (592kg x 317ppk) for Steve Cane of Spriddlestone, Plymouth. Also, an Aberdeen Angus heifer to £1800 (580kg x 311ppk) for Steve Cane again and the better of a pair of smart South Devon females from Sue and Sean in from Moretonhampstead coming back at a hefty £2107 (690kg x 306ppk). Prime steers topped out at 331ppk (668kg & £2207 given for a stunning black Limousin from Tom Yandle who also parted with grand British Blue bullocks for market topping £2209 (758kg x 292ppk) and £2191 (744kg x 295ppk). Other steer prices worthy of a mention included South Devons rising to £2064 (718kg x 288ppk) for Steve Harris of Littlehempston and a super red Limousin steer from Adrian and Bradley Bowden also returning £2064 (644kg \times 321ppk). Cull cows a strong trade too, with a 600kg red Limousin grazing type from Brian Vallance and Family, Bickington easing to a top per kilo of 235 pence and £1407 whist top total price realised in that section was £1748 (918kg x 191ppk) given for a powerhouse of a Stabiliser cow from Will Coleman of Lapford. South Devon cull cows next in line when drawing £1725 (848kg x 204ppk) for Gareth lanes up from Kingsbridge whilst Brian Vallance and Family saw theirs to £1528 and 220ppk. Ed Rhodes, Broadclyst parted with his well-covered Devon barrener for £1475 (804kg x 184ppk) followed by another meaty cow from Steve Cane with an Aberdeen Angus which earned him £1321 (628kg x 211ppk). Hereford cows from | Smerdon and Co of lyybridge ran to £1314 (916kg x 144ppk) and £1292 (728kg \times 178ppk)

1320 PRIME HOGGS & 3 NEW SEASON LAMBS

1320 prime hoggs and 3 prime new season got 2025 off to a very fiery trade in all sections here today from a full compliment of buyers, all eager for sheep. Hoggs saw trade for the heavies just as fiery as last week with 10 pens and 62 head selling in excess of £200 to a top of £218 for Denis Jones and Family of Heasley Mill as Richard & Jill Trace of Sheepwash parted with heavy Dorset hoggs at £217, £212 & £208 and Raymond Jones and Family also of Heasley Mill sold their best at £210. In a three way tie for the top pence per kilo saw two pens from the overweight section at 342ppk, firstly lasmine Hembrow's 59kgs soared to £202 and then Messrs Milborne Wick Farms of Sherborne sold a pair of 57kg Texel's at £195 and all 344 overweights forward, which included a higher percentage of grassy lambs, averaged £182 and 314ppk, back £6 and 10p respectively on the week, but more an indicator of quality.

52kg hoggs to £172 for a smart single from JP Stone of Bridgwater with more of that weight at £165 for Jim Goodenough and Family up from Davidstow as 51's sailed to £169 for Phillip and Richard Harris of

Best of the 50's at £160.50 for the Strong Family of Crockernwell as 49's peaked at £159 for Peace Farm of Bridport and 48's to £155.50 again for the Strong family. Plenty of pens of 46 and 7kg hoggs over £150 to tops of £155 for 46's from Darren Reed of Broadwoodkelly with more that weight at £154 again for Jim Goodenough and Family, a price matched by Steve Cole and Family of Calverleigh with 47's. the third top price of 342ppk was given for the pick of the 45kg hoggs, coming from Stuart Middleton of Cullompton and realising £154 with more of this weight at £153 for the Quick Family of Crediton who also had 44's at £148 and 43's at £144.50. 44kgs topped at £149 for Richard Cole of Knowstone who also had 42's at £14. Other 42's at £140 for both S Stewart of Shillingford and CB Partners of Chevithorne as the best of the 40kgs reached £134 for K Andrews of Exeter and only a couple of pens of lighter weight saw 39's at £129 for BH Lane of Combe Raleigh. SQQ 329ppk, overall average of 319ppk and £157.69.

Just a single pen of three 50kg pure Dorset ram lambs from John Cowell of Black Dog sold readily at £166 or 332ppk.

Only 575 cull sheep and what a trade from start to finish with a fairly washy show of ewes averaging a fairly phenomenal £138!! Purebred continental ewes few and far between with Carmilla Deas down from Taunton topping the sale with a three quarter bred Texel ewe at £278 ahead of a pure Charollais from Andrew Baker of Marldon at £256 and Messrs Vosper up from Warbstow sold a pen of Texel cross ewes well at £234. Other Texel x Mules at £221 for FJ Stacey of Looe, £219 for Jasmine Hembrow of Boconnoc and £207 for Alistair Kirk of Ashwater. Pure Suffolk ewes to £219 for Stuart Middleton, Charollais types at £215 for Mark Harvey of Slapton whilst Ashley Foss of Diptford sold a Cheviot Mule well at £208 and Alan Bickley of Puddington parted with a pen of eight Dorset's at £205. No real best Suffolk crosses forward but Milborne Wick Farms topped at £198 with plenty more business done in the £170's and £180's, often for three quarter meat types. Mules peaked at £182 again for Ashley Foss with several then selling in the £160's and some plain, shelly types looking the trade of the day in the £130's and £140's. Hill ewes saw Jacobs to £126 for the Shinner family of Buckfastleigh, Welsh to £120 for Jim Goodenough and those lighter and leaner sorts in the £70's and £80's all looking very well sold. Tups a good go too, with a whether topping proceedings at £210 for Steve Parish of Chawleigh as Claire Burrough of Axminster sold a heavy Clun Forest ram at £175, FJ Stacey parted with a pair of Berrichons at £160 and both CA Kneebone of Lifton and Alan Bickley saw their boys make £158. A single goat made £120 for the Frankum family of Whitstone and the overall average for all cull sheep was up £16 for a far worse show of sheep today. In reality trade could have been £30 better on some sheep and as dear as we've EVER seen them!
