Prime Cattle to 370ppk & £2453 Cull Cows to 256ppk & £1992

No let up in the recent incredible increase in cattle returns here at Exeter on Monday with both prime and cull stock looking as dear as we have seen them. Finished steers topped out at a considerable £2453 (664kg x 370ppk) given for a tremendous red Limousin from Adrian and Bradley Bowden of Drewsteignton followed by their next best steer with the same favourable comments which eased to £2358 (656kg x 360ppk). Other standout steer prices to catch the eye included decent British Blues coming back at £2342 (782kg x 300ppk) for David Slade of Chagford together with well farmed sorts from Steve Cane of Spriddlestone, Plymouth when he sold strong Herefords to £2109 (652kg x 324ppk) and smart South Devon Bullocks for £2082 (654kg x 319ppk). Best of the prime heifers came from RJ Macbean and Son of Plymstock who sadly sold the very last of their cattle here at Exeter on Monday when parting with a super British Blue for £2216 (620kg \times 358ppk) whilst David Slade sold a lighter Blue female for £1809 (570kg \times 318ppk). Further heifer returns of note saw a tidy red Limousin from Adrian and Bradley Bowden realise £1932 (556kg x 348ppk) and a South Devon from John and Andrew Ball of Stoke Gabriel gross £1923 (570kg x 338ppk). Cull cows saw a top price of £1992 (780kg x 256ppk) for a grand red Limousin from Stephen Voysey in from Longdown whilst Tony Francis, Okehampton sold a black Limousin for £1317 (5925kg x 223ppk) and a Simmental cow at £1587 (754kg x 211ppk). Plenty of other good bodied cows hovering around that 200ppk mark with Herefords reaching £1300 (652kg x 200ppk) for Steve Cane, Devon crosses at £1234 (622kg x 199ppk) for Nick Toms of lyybridge together with Galloways making £1194 (602kg x 199ppk) for J Smerdon and Co of the same parish and Aberdeen Angus barreners reaching £1116 (554kg x 202ppk) for John and Andrew Ball.

2095 PRIME HOGGS

What a day for mid January in the sheep pens! 2100 prime hoggs and 1200 cull sheep meeting tremendous trades in all sections with everything every bit as dear as last week. The largest entry of prime sheep ever seen

in January at Exeter sold well in front of an animated crowd of buyers all keen to spend and secure hoggs for much all major national major Overweights adding up nicely with 8 pens and 44 head selling in excess of £200 to a top of £214.50 given for 69kg Suffolk x Mules from Denis Jones and family of Heasley Mill who sold another pen of 66kg of the same breeding at £207.50 and his best pen of 64kg Texel crosses at £207 and more of the same at 63kgs realising £202.50. Jess Baulch of North Tawton sold a single 69kg hogg at £212 as Dave Chapple of Cadeleigh sold his similar weight singles at £210 & £209 and Paul Vanstone of Bratton Clovelly saw his heaviest make £202. Top per kilo in the overweights went to Mark Harvey of Slapton with tremendous 55kg continental hoggs at £183.50 or 334ppk with four vendors reaching 329ppk, both Milborne Wick Farms of Sherborne and Paul Vanstone sold 56's at £184, Denis Jones and family had a double pen of 54kgs at £177.50 and the Neale family of Boyton sold 53's at £174.50 as well as the top price

52kgs at £172 (331ppk). 51kgs to £171 or 335ppk from Jilly Handley of Sampford Courtenay and a tremendous 47kg single hoggs from Paul Bowden of Drewsteignton soared to £170 and a market topping 362ppk. Plenty of other 50-52kg hoggs trading in the £160's with Dave Chapple's 46's claiming £160.50 and Aaron Vanstone of Bratton Clovelly selling his own Charollais type hoggs at 47kgs to make £160 with the bulk of the good 46-48kg hoggs selling from £152 to £157. 45's to £156 for both Messrs White and Tucker of Cheriton Fitzpaine and Roger Snell of Burrington who also sold 44's at £152.50 and no less than twelve further pens of 44-45kg hoggs trading £150 and above. 43's to £149.50 for the Strong family of Crockernwell and £149 for MG Curtis of Morchard Road as 41's peaked at £144.50 for Ken Chapple of Oakford, £144 for the Baxter family of Exwick and £143 for Dave Fox of Cheriton Fitzpaine. 40kgs to £142 and 355ppk for Robin Irwin of Kings Nympton as 39's reached £130 for Suffolk x Welsh from Mark Clinnick of Ivybridge and 38kgs reached £130.50 (343ppk) again for the Strong family. A high percentage of Mule wethers, Welsh and Welsh cross hoggs, Easycare's as well as Jacobs and Dartmoors included in today's genuine averages of 326ppk, £151/hd with an SQQ of 330ppk, which doesn't really reflect the true strength of the trade.

More cull sheep forward at 1202 head but no let up in trade with another very mixed show of ewes averaging £136 overall although at points in the middle of the sale we averaging in the £150's until we went outside to the raft of hill and smaller bred ewes. That said all shapes, sizes breeds and numbers all warmly welcomed here to Exeter with yet more fresh vendors following the movement and selling sheep here today from as far away as Warminster in Wiltshire. Only a few pens of best ewes and in truth these no dearer with Texel's at £275 for the Quick family of Crediton, at £270 & £258 for Messrs Anytime Anywhere Ltd of Launceston and £248 for the Neale family also of Launceston. A big Texel x Suffolk type ewe at £238 for Tom Yandle of Oxton as the Quick family sold crossbreds in large pens at £228 & £220, Mark Harvey saw his best make £220, both Paul Bowden and Keith Milton of Pennymoor made £218 and Simon Norman down from Taunton sold the best of his run of 130 here today to a top of £217. The top 27 prices in the ewes all over £200 with Dorset's, Zwartbles and numerous crossbreds all breaking that barrier. Mules regularly in the £160's and £170's to a top of £178 for a large pen from Tony & Marie Kemmish of Morchard Bishop with leaner and lighter types still looking the dearest from £120 to £140. An abundance of hill ewes here today with Cheviot's to £167 for Julie & Ed Willaims of Ilsington, Exmoor Horns to £150 for Ray Tucker of Bridford, Whitefaced Dartmoors to £129 for the Caunter family of Ipplepen and a super pen of Herdwicks very near the end of the day from the Charlotte Drew of Upottery flew to £121 with plenty of Scotch, Welsh and Dartmoor ewes wither side of £100. Tups to £228 again for a tremendous Texel from Anytime Anywhere as Ray Tucker saw his worked sorts sell readily at £176, £170 & £168. Just a tremendous trade from start to finish here on a day where many more could have been sold and the trade really did have to be seen to be believed.
