Store Steers to £1760 Store Heifers to £1500

Several more cattle about this week with well over 500 store cattle penned and sold and although we were always confident that those stronger, short term store cattle sold against the strong finished price would hold their own this week, we were a little concerned how we would get on selling the multitude of poorer dairy bred types we had entered. Thankfully the big crowd of buyers in attendance, both from home and away ensured our fears were not realised as demand right across the board looked as strong as ever. Grand British Blue steers (23m) from Chris Poad up from St Dominick headed that section when his eye catching bunch of six drew a creditable £1760 followed by further Blues of a similar age from David and Wendy Holland, Dolton at £1640 for pen of four. The latter also parted with a single rangy Simmental bullock (22m) for £1675 with other strong steers close at £1665 for a couple of decent Limousin's (27m) from Gordon and Gill White in from Coleford and a cracking trio of South Devon's (24m) at £1655 for Sue and Sean Cleave of Moretonhampstead. Chris Poad back when selling a super Charolais bullock (24m) for £1650 and an Aberdeen Angus of the same age for £1560. Much younger Charolais (just 10m) from Peter Heard of Okehampton drew a very creditable £1470 and Fred Ellicott of Taunton saw his cracking bunch of four Charolais steers (17m) rise to £1455 apiece. Other steers prices of interest included a solitary Beef Shorthorn (22m) at £1540 for David and Wendy Holland, a pair of stout Devon's (36m) from Nick Toms of lyybridge which came back at £1460 each and a British Blonde (26m) from Mattew Wilson from Dunsford at £1440. Also, Hereford steers (25m) from Gordon and Gill White fetched £1380 and a pen of fine Stabiliser bullocks (17m) from Mark Irish of Ashburton reached £1210. Perhaps not the strength in the heifers as we saw last week although a well summered British Blue (21m) from Tracey Tope of Chudleigh did see a very respectable £1500 together British Blonde and Charolais (17m) coming back at £1440 for Peter Hendy of Plymouth and a pen of five Charolais (18m) from Keith Chapple of Cheriton Fitzpaine realised £1425 apiece. More young Charolais (13m) from Peter Heard look well sold at £1270 each as did an aged (35m) Devon from Nick Toms at £1360. Simmental heifers (17m) next up when selling readily and to £1305 for Peter Heard again followed by a neat bunch of six (21m) from Mike Brain in from Cove which racked up £1270 apiece. Stuart Westcott of Longdown also saw his big suckler bred Limousin (23m) rise to £1270 whilst dairy crossbred sorts of the same age and breed saw a bunch of eight from the Flete Estate, Plymouth sell for £1200. Pretty Aberdeen Angus females (22m) ran to £1225 for Nick and Shane Willis in from Kennford whilst Gordon and Gill White saw a couple of handy Herefords (25m) take home £1140 and Mark Irish parted with his best pen of Stabiliser's (17m) for £1030.

Eighteen well-bred and fed Devon organic registered steers (18m) from Mrs Pamela Idelson-Smith of Poundstock saw her top pen of four reach a well-deserved £1280 apiece

Trade remaining strong on the whole with the harder done cattle perhaps starting to see a little more resistance. Top of the day saw Charolais cross steers from Charlie Hutchings in from Bradninch top out at £960 with Blue steers off the same good farm to £875 & £740. The Mortimore Family in from Chagford presented suckler bred Charolais cross steers (8m) which looked well sold at £940. RM & SJ Middleton in from Woodbury presented dairy bred Hereford steers (12m) which hit £755 whilst the Lee Family of Rackenford presented Blue steers of a similar ilk to £700. Limousin steers from James Coates of Saltash realised £690 with further Blues to £650. Best of the Friesians saw JR & A Down in from Whiddon Down obtain £600 (11m). Heifers topped at £770 from the Mortimore Family presenting a good pen of Charolais crosses (8m). Dairy bred Limousin cross heifers from JR & A Down hit £680 (10m) whilst the Cuming Family of Honiton presented their Hereford cross heifers (12m) which achieved £570. Further dairy bred heifers, this time from James Coates saw his Limousin heifers level out at £550, whilst younger types being Blues (6m) from DR Stacey of St Austell realised £515.

Another good show of calves here at Exeter sold to yet again a powerful trade. The market was topped by James Warren, Penzance who sold a well farmed, older Limousin at £435. Younger fresh Limousin calves saw strong demand making £290, £280 and £260 all presented by AR Hooper & Partners, Spreyton. Very smart Simmental bulls sold to £390 x2 in from KG and SRJ Wotton, Dittisham. Outstanding Charolais bulls to £370 sold by MR & KL Davey, Lewdown. Young Blue bulls to £365 for AP, RE and ME Retter, Monkton and £340 HMV Weekes, Cullompton. Strong Hereford bulls to £390 James Warren again and strong Angus bulls reached £295 R and EJ Phillips, South Molton. Reared heifers soared away to £445 for James Warren, Penzance, a smashing young month-old Blue heifer out of a Montbeliard cow made £335 for DW Cole & Son, Bradninch. Others to £255 Evershot Farms Ltd. Smart Limousin heifers to £225 for Dare Farms Ltd, Simmental heifers to £180 KG & SRJ Wotton again. Calves remain a decent trade, keep them coming!

A massive entry of 255 Dairy Cattle with vendors from as far as Kent, Worcester, Wiltshire and across the South West saw an excellent trade for what was forward. The fresh milk sold to a strong trade topping at £2250 for a fourth calver "Westwood Kimball Bluebell VG88" from Messrs JUF Reed & Son of Crediton who sold other third calvers to £2150 & £2000 twice to average £1888 of the 10. Messrs JS Bird & Son of Axminster sold a nice second calver "Bartonwood System Fleur 4" at £2050 and a heifer "Bartonwood Unix Fawn" at £1950. A consignment of Organic heifers from Dave Hunt of South Brent sold to another flying trade topping at £2000 for a British Friesian heifer with a Brown Swiss x heifer close behind at £1950 and Ayrshire heifers to £1850 & £1800. The Dispersal Sale of Friesian & Crossbred Cows on behalf of Nigel Goldsworthy of Truro sold to an excellent trade topping at £1820gns for a fourth calver fresh in July with other similar cows to 1750gns and fifth calvers to 1620gns twice. The overall average was £1187 including all faulted and many older cows. In Calf Heifers topped at £1550 three times for British Friesian heifers from Andrew & Liz Hammett of Umberleigh with others to £1420 for the Phillips Partnership of Cornwall. The Phillips Partnership also sold smart bulling and maiden heifers to £800 & £700. Pedigree Ayrshire Bulling heifers from the Wroguhton herd of Mike Windel of Wiltshire.

The Autumn Gold Sale of Pedigree Jerseys saw a massive entry of Jerseys and an excellent trade. Only a small number of fresh milk sold to a strong trade topping at 1700gns for a fresh heifer "Brastead Steve Angel" from Messrs Edgar & Son of Kent who consigned 41 head and sold other fresh heifers to 1450gns & 1400gns twice. Other fresh heifers sold to 1500gns three times for Whitenhill Jersey Partners of Umberleigh. These three heifers from Whitenhill all sold with their heifer calves at foot selling to 300gns, 280gns & 250gns. Other heifers sold to 1400gns for Ashley Johns of Cornwall and a Quintrell bred third calver sold well at 1450gns for lan Pugsley of Exeter. In Calf Heifers sold to a better than expected trade topping at 1450gns with others to 1400gns & 1350gns for heifers due in the next two months and spring calving heifers sold to strong demand also selling to 1200gns for Messrs Edgar & Son.
