#### **Store Steers to £1780 Store Heifers to £1600**

Numbers now starting to drop off as we enter that quieter festive period time of the year, although that only looks to have sparked even stronger demand with the ever present buyer support once again here at Exeter seeing trade motoring on. Top of the day was given for an eye catching pair of British Blue steers (26m) from Dan Gould of Taunton at £1780 a head who also saw others, a little younger (22m) ease £1700 for a pen of four followed by later born Blue bullocks (16m) still making £1575 for Adam and Kate Partridge of Poundsgate. A solitary, grand Beef Shorthorn steer (22m) from Roger and James Mugford up from Diptford easily reached £1760 with further Shorthorns (18m) also on the wanted list when drawing £1195 for Dave Sluggett and Family from Broadclyst. Charolais bred steers up next when a well farmed bunch of four (20m) from Dan Gould came back at £1715 apiece with the better of the younger Charolais (14m) coming from Rob Thorn of Chagford with a couple returning him £1300 a life. Also, smart South Devon steers (18m) from Adam and Kate Partridge rose to £1685. Jonathan Strout made a worthwhile trip up from Rilla Mill with a box of strong steers and parted with his very best a solid looking Limousin (24m) for £1660 whilst top price for the many good Hereford bullocks on show saw a trio (20m) make £1545 apiece for Roger and James Mugford followed by another pen of three sold by Andrew Banbury, Crediton for £1465 a head. Other native breed steers of note included Aberdeen Angus (20m) picking up £1455 and Devon's of a similar age to £1380 both for Roger and James Mugford. Onto the store heifers where we saw a high of £1600 given for a pair of well turned out Aberdeen Angus from Graham Hawking in from Thorverton whilst much younger, but decent Angus females (15m) sold in a group of six from David Parris and Family of Upottery still climbed to £1075 a life. A super run of store heifers from Andrew Peters and Family of Talaton met strong demand with their best pen of British Blues (25m) taking home £1560 whilst a cracking black Limousin (26m) off the same farm ran to £1305, further heifers of those breeds saw well farmed Blues (24m) rise to £1480 for Toby and Bev Boys of East Allington and young, sprightly Limousin's (16m) from Rob Thorn fetching £1190 apiece for a pair. Barry and Rachel Mildon and Family of Cadbury were back for a third week with the quality of their stock not dropping and parting with an outstanding entry of Charolais heifers (18m) sold in bunches for £1530, £1485 and £1450 whilst Brian Cunningham up from Dartington saw his super Charolais (24m) reach £1490. Straight dairy bred type heifers saw Fleckvieh's (27m) sell at £1400 and £1360 for MW & SE Wooldridge of Burrington and CR and IM Carr from Cheriton Fitzpaine respectively. The latter also parted with a tidy Simmental store bull (15m) for £1200.
