Store Steers to £1950 Store Heifers to £1650

A decent entry of well over 100 head of store cattle here at Exeter considering we are in the run up to Christmas with all sellers gratefully receiving the early gift of an exceptional trade right across the board with those poorer, younger stores looking just as dear in comparison as the many headline grabbing well bred, stronger sorts on offer. Steers topped out at £1950 given for an eye catching, powerful Aberdeen Angus (26m) from Andrew Banbury of Crediton whilst smart younger (21m) Angus bullocks from Hubert Chugg, Stockleigh Pomeroy still looked well sold when rising to £1440 as did later again born ones (14m) at £1010 for Maydown Farm Ltd of Bridport. Several forward British Blues about again this week with the very best steers (30m) reaching £1760 apiece for a tremendous trio from Derek Pyle in from Clyst Honiton with others of the same quality but a little younger (27m) drawing £1720 for Andrew Banbury again and yearling Blue steers coming back at £1275 for a neat bunch of six from William Hosegood and Family of Zeal Monarchorum. The latter also parted with a pen of four mixed Simmental and Friesian steers (16m) for £1630 apiece whilst a single Friesian steer (23m) from Roger Calcraft of Aylesbeare fetched £1540. Other store steer prices of interest included good British Blonde steers (30m) making £1680 for Derek Pyle, Montbeliarde's (22m) at £1480 for Hubert Chugg together with four neat Limousin bred steers (15m) taking home £1410 a life for William Hosegood and Family and a pen of five Herefords (20m) reaching £1360 a head for Robert Moore from Diptford. Also, well bred Salers steers (16m) saw £1345 for Terry and Jenifer Arscott in from Chagford. Onto the store heifers where we saw plenty of size and cover throughout the sale with the very best rising to ± 1650 given for a meaty Aberdeen Angus (33m) from Paul Belworthy of Exeter whilst younger (18m) Angus females still reached £1100 for Chris Irish from Ashburton. Hefty Hereford heifers (30m) up next when realising £1530 a piece for three from Paul Belworthy followed by South Devon's (27m) making £1470 for Chris Irish and a pair of stout Simmental bred females (23m) sold at £1400 each for Roger Calcraft. As with the steers there were plenty of older, forward British Blue heifers around this week too with pairs (23m) rising to £1370 and £1300 for RN Giles and Son of Down Thomas with later born Blue females (14m) seeing pens ease to £1135 and £1110 for William Hosegood and Family who also parted with three delightful Limousin's for £1280 a life. The grazing cow section was headed by a Devon from A and T Lee of Cadbury which drew £1400.

A small offering of stirks and suckled calves met yet another wonderful trade to finish the year. RA & CM Wonnacott & Sons in from Chagford presented useful Charolais cross steers (10m) which raced to £1010. Roger White of South Zeal sold South Devon steers (6m) which realised £810 whilst the best of a run of dairy bred stirks from William Hosegood & Family in from Zeal Monachorum saw Simmental crosses (8m) achieve £750 with Fleckvieh steers of a similar age to £655. Younger, weaned calves being Limousin cross steers (4m) hit £510 with Simmentals to £435. Heifers topped out at £785 for RA & CM Wonnacott & Sons with the best of the dairy bred heifer stirks from William Hosegood & Family being Limousin crosses (9m) hitting £670 with younger weaned sorts to £425 (4m). Stabilizer heifers from A & T Lee of Cadbury realised £560 (10m). A run of bulls from Besley Dairy down from Wellington saw Hereford crosses (10m) hit £860.

Another full shed of sheep again this week, despite being so close to Christmas with 2337 heads in total with nearly 2200 store lambs. The sale started with just 8 orphan lambs which met fierce bidding and sold to \pounds 49 for three pure Dorset's from Peter Vooght of South Brent as Alan Bickley of Puddington sold three of the same well at \pounds 46 and Dave Chapple of Cadeleigh had a nice Charollais sired lamb at \pounds 44. Overall average \pounds 45.

2188 STORE LAMBS

The store lambs this morning just kept on coming with 2188 forward, but noticeably not the strength and quality of last week, and hence not quite the trade either. That said top money at £160 went to Dorset ewe lambs from the Vallance family of Liverton as David & Lynda Pellow of Sourton sold Suffolk x Mules well at £155, £147 & £144 with Bilberry Estates of Moretonhampstead at £148 & £144.50 again with Suffolk crosses as Mark & John Moore of Rackenford reached £146 with their best. Plenty more in the £140's with Brian Palfrey of Stoodleigh at £145, John & June Philp of Ilsington at £144.50 and Jon & Cathy Bowles of Slapton at £143.50 and £143. Mediums usually still £105 to £125 and lesser sorts back in the £80's and £90's which we've maybe not seen too much of recently. A lot of clearing up sorts here today and some of which were sold as seen with warts and all but all included in the overall average of £108.84 back just over £5 on the week but in truth the quality today was nowhere near last week's.


