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

Store Steers to £1780 Store Heifers to £1560

Store cattle dearer again on the week when Friday saw a blistering trade, not only for those forward, short term sorts sold in wake of the of the ever improving finished price, but also for the many runs of suckler and dairy bred middling types which all look to have summered well and were the trade of the day. Top quality Charolais bullocks (22-24m) headed the steer section when an outstanding pen of five from Alan Hembrow and Family up from Lostwithiel eased to £1780 apiece followed by a trio from Gordon Gooding, Ottery st Mary at £1770 and a pair of crackers from Darren and Harry Cole of Mary Tavy which shot to £1745 each. Later born Charolais (15m) again from Darren and Harry Cole still drew £1385 for a bunch of five tidy sorts. British Blue steers (21m) next up when making £1720 and £1640 for David and Andy Mortimer in from Sowton Village followed by more top notch red Limousins (26m) from Mark Wooldridge of Okehampton who saw a bunch of five rise to £1530 apiece with younger (20m) Limousin bullocks came back at £1530 for Alan Hembrow and Family. Johnny Haimes up from Plymouth brought a big run of strong, well farmed dairy bred stores and saw his best return £1500 for a grand Hereford steer (24m) followed by a couple of Aberdeen Angus (20m) from Johnny at £1480 each. A shapely South Devon steer (18m) sold amongst a matching group of Limousins picked up £1400 for Darren and Harry Cole whilst a pair of meaty Bazadaise steers (just 13m) realised £1240 a head for Campbell and Jackie Hill of Downderry and four rangy Friesian bullocks (22m) fetched £1190 for Steve and Sam Middleton in from Woodbury. As with the steers the heifer section was topped by standout Charolais when Alan Hembrow and Family saw four super ones (21m) reach £1560 a price matched by Darren and Harry Cole when their Charolais (24m) also proved popular when again making £1560, these were trailed by good Limousin store heifers, firstly from Mark Wooldridge with a couple (26m) at £1450 then two more (23m) were close at £1430 for Simon Jervis of Ideford. Dave Luckett and Family back for a second week selling their eye catching South Devon cattle and saw heifers (17m) to £1290 whilst Aberdeen Angus females (27m) from Johnny Haimes earned him £1270 for a pair and the better of several British Blue heifer on show saw the very best (21m) hit £1265 and £1260 for Steve and Sam Middleton and Gordon Gooding respectively. Also, a well kept trio of British Blonde heifers (26m) from Terry Gillbard, Puddington rose to £1150 apiece. Other cattle through the store cattle ring saw a young (25m) Simmental bull from Rob Anthony of Tedburn st Mary make £1380 whist Geoff and Nicky Arscott, Chagford parted with fine grazing cows for £1410 for Limousins with their Charolais realising £1360 and Salers to £1250.

Steers to £1100 heifers to £800

A tremendous turnout of youngstock in the stirk section this week and what a trade! Demand, right across was exceptional with all ages and types selling to a premium. An eye catching suckler bred Charolais steer (9m) topped the sale when drawing an impressive £1100 for Geoff and Nicky Arscott of Chagford followed by younger (7m) but just as smart, beef cross Charolais reaching £950 for Phil Medland in from Tavistock. Geoff and Nicky Arscott back when selling smart Limousin steers (9m) to £980 and £920 whilst dairy crossbred Limousins of the same age from James Horton of Milton abbot eased to £880 for a trio. D Hutchings down from Taunton saw strong dairy British blue steers (10m) to £960 for a pen of six while perhaps the trade of the day was for a big run of Organic calves from Martin Bennett and Family of Broadhembury who parted with big bunches of Blues (10m) for a top of £930. Phil Medland sold three young (6m) South Devon steers for £930 and a Hereford of the same age for £720. A couple of Charolais heifers (8m) from Phil Medland headed that section and drew £800 followed by Josh Webber in from Yarcombe with his pair of Charolais (9m) reaching £750 each. Best of the Blue heifers ran to £790 for a smart one (7m) from Andrew Taylor down from Exford whilst Martin Bennett and Family saw theirs (9m) realise £740 and Josh Webber sold a solid looking bunch of seven of that age for £720 apiece. A yearling Aberdeen Angus female from Rob Davis of Chagford returned him £730 followed by young (7m) Limousin stirk heifers at £710 for both James Horton and Andrew Taylor.

A small entry of milk saw a very mixed quality entry but a cracking trade! The two best heifers probably looked decent value and topped at £2000 for Phillip Clarke of Aylesbeare who sold another at £1850. Dave Hunt of South Brent sold a consignment of 5 organic fresh heifers to a top of £1920 for a British Friesian heifer with a Norwegian Red x heifer close behind at £1900, a Swedish Red heifer to £1820 and a Fleckvieh x heifer to £1780. Mike & James Wooldridge of Umberleigh sold two Fleckvieh x heifers to £1700 each and two pedigree Jersey heifers from Messrs FE Murley & Sons of Penzance sold very well to £1680 & £1620. A pedigree Ayrshire cow sold well at £1600 for the Davis Family of Tiverton. A consignment of grazing type Friesian & Crossbred cows from Burrow Farm Partnership of Broadclyst sold well to £1650 for a Jersey x fourth calver with others to £150 & £1500. A Swedish Red x in calf heifer sold at £1150 for Linda Knight of Highampton. Jersey x bulling and yearling heifers sold to a much better trade than expected with bullers topping at £570 for Mr R Hawke of Launceston with other groups to £540 & £530. Younger Jersey x yearling heifers sold to £560 x 5 & £500 x 4 for Matt & Scott Broom of Honiton.

1146 STORE LAMBS/HOGGS

Numbers similar on the week with 1146 store lambs and trade just about as fiery as last week, although the quality of lambs was far more variable with runs of local Whiteface and Greyface Dartmoors, Welsh lambs and Shetlands not helping the average. Georgina Came of Ashburton topped the sale with a forward pen at \pounds 145, as Nigel Tucker of Long Drag sold his best at \pounds 143, the Jordan family of Chagford sold a triplet altogether at \pounds 131 apiece and Georgie Beer of Aveton Gifford sold a large pen at \pounds 128.50. Plenty of forward sorts from \pounds 110 to \pounds 125 whilst those lambs to come out in the early new year were either side of \pounds 100 and longer term lambs every bit as dear as last week and usually always \pounds 85 to \pounds 95, with the exception of the less desirable hill breed's which were often \pounds 40 to \pounds 75 and all competitively bid for and leaving an overall average of \pounds 96.

33 GRAZING EWES, RAMS & GOATS

A shortage of grazers saw a Billy Goat top the sale at £140 for DA & MJ Johnson of Crediton as AR Henson of Washfield sold a ewe at £110 and the next step down in the £80's and £90's and only one sheep less than £68.

50 BREEDING EWES

A few breeders saw AR Henson sell both his Suffolk x FM & Dorset x FM's at £140 and MFS Ltd of Farringdon sold his best at £116.

4 EWES & 4 LAMBS (8 LIVES)

A consignment of couples from John Bond of East Allington sold to \pounds 250 for two Mule Shearlings with young Suffolk x singles whilst Suffolk x Mules with the same comments made \pounds 218.

35 GREYFACE DARTMOOR FEMALES & 35 RAMS

The annual show and sale of Greyface Dartmoor sheep on behalf of the Dartmoor Sheep breeders association saw selective trades for both the females and rams on offer with plenty of sheep on offer and something to suite all budgets. Best shearling ewes to 350gns for the Champion pair from EA Dawson of Shropshire whilst older ewes peaked at 260gns for M Osborne of Bude, Kate Jeans of Wotter sold shearlings at 260gns, 230gns & 170gns as J & R Gatrill of Wells sold their best at 230gns and another two pairs at 200gns and 200gns also for Peter, Susie & William Dunster of Totnes. Rams peaked at 1000gns for F Ledgerwood of Totnes as Messrs Hampstead and daughter of Boston Lincs sold the Champion at 800gns and a further six rams sold between 300 & 400gns.


