Store Steers to £1875 Store Heifers to £1480

Friday saw a typical low harvest turnout of store cattle as we often do see at this time of the year with those sellers that did venture out well rewarded with as strong a trade as we have seen since the turn of the year. The very mixed quality entry of stores on offer saw those lessor, harder done steers and heifers sell every bit as well as their stronger better bred counterparts in comparison with buyers here at Exeter every week for all types. Steers topped at a very creditable £1875 given for a pair of outstanding red Limousin's (21m) from Chris Lentern of Chagford whilst four more red Limousin bullocks of a similar age and with the same good comments from Andrew Cleave in from Christow rose to £1730 apiece and a couple of later born ones (14m) sold for Sam and Roger Chestnutt of Okehampton drew £1430 a life. Charolais steers next in line when a trio of striking sorts (25m) from Steve Palmer, Moretonhampstead reached £1700 each followed by much younger Charolais bullocks (14m) from Peter Hendy of Staddiscombe, Plymouth which levelled out at £1540 apiece for a pen of three. The Matthews Family up from Torpoint brought another load of their quality home bred South Devon cattle and saw a bunch of their head turning steers (18m) ease to £1645 whilst the best of the British Blue steers realised £1530 for a couple (25m) from Duncan Parris and Family of Yarcombe and £1420 for a single Blue of the same age sold on behalf of David Meyrick of the same parish. David Meyrick back when selling well farmed Aberdeen Angus bullocks (29m) for £1470 and well covered Devon's (28m) for £1360 whilst further Angus steers worthy of a mention including a trio (27m) from Rob Davies of Diptford at £1450 and a bunch of six (22m) close at £1435 each for Duncan Parris and Family. A solitary, grand Friesian steer sold by David Parris and family of Upottery looked decent money at £1340 as did a Hereford (18m) at £1225 from NJ Broom and Sons in from Colyton. Very smart yearling steers saw a bunch of six mainly Gascon bred ones fetch £1140 apiece for Sam and Roger Chestnutt and a British Blonde (10m) from David Pengelly and Family of Kentisbeare rose to £1060. Some fantastic store heifers on offer this week with the very best coming from Trevor and Martine Snell of Sidmouth in the way of a pair of Simmental's (27m) at £1480 and a couple of Charolais (28m) from Steve Palmer not far back at £1460 apiece. Aberdeen Angus females (22m) ran to £1390 for Rob Summers in from Harcombe, Sidmouth followed by British Blue's at £1370 (27m) from Rob Davies and £1340 (22m) for David Parris and Family. Rob Summers returning when parting with Limousin heifers (20m) for £1320 and a couple of British Blonde's (21m) for £1200. Further Limousin bred heifers of note (15m) came from Sam and Roger Chestnutt when a neat bunch (which did include two super Gascon's) easily reached £1245 whilst a single Limousin female (24m) from Rob and Sue Greep of Cornwood came back at £1200. David Pengelly and Family saw their South Devon heifer (24m) make £1215 and a Friesian female (25m) sold by James Warren and Family up from Penzance came back at £1030.

Trade remaining fast in particular for the better end types. Josh Webber down from Yarcombe presented neat dairy bred Blues (10m) which topped out at £860 with other pens realising £830. Further dairy bred types from Malcolm Harris up from Slapton saw Hereford x steers (9m) which achieved £810 with Limousins off the same good farm achieving £780. FS Davies Partnership from Crediton present Hereford x steers (8m) which reached £770 whilst Richard Langdon & Family down from Molland saw Limousin x steers (12m) hit £695. David Pengally & Son from Cullompton topped the heifers reaching £900 for blues (9m). Melanie Forward saw a good run of Hereford x heifers (9m) top out at £860 with others to £740 and £660. Malcolm Harris saw his Limousin x heifers (9m) reach £690 whilst further Hereford heifers from FS Davies & Partnership attained £620. Younger dairy bred blues from M Tucker achieved £605 whilst GFL Dairy down from Templeton achieved £510.

An increased entry of calves penned on Friday sold to yet again another flyer of a trade. Top of the tree was a trio of very smart Blue bulls which were weaned and saw huge interest and raced away to an impressive £590 (3-4m x3), presented by Nicola Chanin of Thorverton. Younger on milk Blue bulls sold to £395 for Rob Kennor of Lapford, £370 for DW Rowe & Sons of Axminster and £305 for D W Cole & Son of Bradnich. Best Limousin bulls reached £390, £375 and £305 all presented by the Horton Family up from Roborough. Charolais bulls to £260 for MR & KM Pring of Broadclyst. Angus bulls in strong demand to a top of £210 for AC & ER Hammett of Kings Nympton. Heifers reached a huge £510 for a sweet pair of weaned Blues in from Nicola Chanin again. Younger Blue heifers sold to £270, £268 and £260 for D W Rowe & Sons again. Hereford heifers selling well to £340 for KG & SRJ Wotton of Dittisham and £220 for M Harris of Slapton. Smart Limousin heifers to £268 and £258 all from the Horton Family again.

Top of the day 2750gns!

A super entry of dairy cattle saw an excellent trade from start to finish! A consignment of grazing type British Friesian and Crossbred cows & heifers from Messrs AR Hooper & Partners of Spreyton sold to an exceptional trade topping at £2200 for a third calver with others to £2000, £1900, £1850 & £1800. A consignment of British Friesian in calf heifers due August-December from Messrs AD Bulled & Son of Barnstaple sold well to a top of £1480 x 2 with others to £1350 x 2 & £1250 x 2.

James Warren & Family of Penzance sold a consignment of 110 pedigree Holsteins, Jerseys & Guernseys. The 21 Holstein in milk cows & heifers sold to an exceptional trade topping at 2750gns for "Bartinney Frazor Snowy 2 VG86" a fresh heifer by Chettiscombe Frazor. Close behind at 2650gns was a fresh second calver "Bartinney Score Bevin VG85". At 2500gns was the much-admired black heifer "Bartinney Altavelvet Faithful GP82" by Peak Altavelvet. Other heifers to 2450gns and cows to 2400gns & 2200gns. The Holstein milkers averaged £2055! The 10 in milk Jersey cows & heifers sold to a solid trade topping at 1550gns twice for "Cardinney Maid Claire 13 VG85" a heifer by Sunset Canyon Got Maid and "Cardinney Lemonhead Deborah 4 VG85" a heifer by Steinhauers Samson Lemonhead. Other cows sold to 1520gns & 1500gns averaging at £1428. Holstein in calf heifers sold to a cracking trade topping at 2300gns for "Bartinney Santos Pledge" due in August to sexed Hampshire. Also at 2300gns was "Bartinney Lambda Savoire Fare" backed by 10 generations of VG or EX dams, she sold due in October to Westcoast Altamater. Other heifers made 2100gns, 2000gns, 1950gns & 1900gns. Jersey in calf heifers topped at 1200gns for "Cardinney Maid Osier 25" due in October to Chocochip. Guernsey in calf heifers topped at 1400gns for "Tredinney Novak Maud 14" with others close behind at 1350gns. Maiden heifers saw a stronger than anticipated trade, Holsteins topped at 2400gns for "Bartinney Lambda Chassity" an April born heifer by Farnear Delta-Lambda bred from 10 generations of VG or EX dams. More commercial pedigree bulling heifers sold between 700-820gns. Guernseys saw an excellent trade topping at 1250gns for "Tredinney Beau Bunty 29" A May born daughter of Trewey Juno Beau. Not far behind at 1000gns was "Tredinney Bountiful Lobelia 7". Jerseys sold perhaps a little better than anticipated but still looked decent value topping at 650gns with others to 600gns & 550gns.

Another seasonally quiet day in the sheep pens with 820 forward and sold, but trade in all sections was pleasing given the tumbling prime prices currently being experienced. A lorry load of store lambs down from Buckinghamshire boosted the numbers and dominated the top prices when Rob & Caroline Mole of Chearsley parted with their fine run of Charollais sired lambs at £121.50, £119.50, £118, £117 & £116.50 whilst David Morris of Brill saw his best pens of Suffolk x Mules at £119 & £117.50. Mark Clinnick of lyybridge reached £115 twice and both Graham Hill of Wiggaton and Mark Brown of Uplowman saw their best make £113.50. Keeping lambs generally £80 to £100 and plenty of farmers looking to purchase in this price bracket whilst today's entry also saw a few bottom end, very young, non descript and Milk sheep lambs trading upwards of £50. Average back £4 on the week at £96.

Grazers sold to £141 & £140 for the Thompson family of Diptford as Vicky Haywood of Ideford sold rams at £134 and James Skevington of Washbourne saw £124 for his best ewes. Grazers averaged £113.

29 EWES/HOGGS & 44 LAMBS (73 LIVES)

Still a surprising number of couples on offer for the last week in June with 29 ewes and 44 lambs seeing plenty of interest and trade for the goods on offer. Archie Hill of Shepton Mallet stole the show with his Blue Texel 4T single ewe realizing £350 (£175/life). Russell James of Ashburton sold a young Cheviot ewe with twins at £328 (£109/life) whilst Marlon Warren of Whitestone parted with a Mule hogg twin at £250 and S White, up from Tavistock sold 8 with 15 well at £245 or £85 and similarly Luke Parsons of Stoke Sub Hampton received £220 for his 9 with 15 or £82.50 per life. Hogg singles to £175 and £168 with BM singles also looking well sold at £160 from various homes and a few Herdwick ewes with young lambs selling to £92 for singles from Jeremy Skelton of Launceston.
