Store Steers to £1770 Store Heifers to £1650

A few more store cattle about this week and although those on offer were generally of a poorer quality than we have seen of late what we did see were all well summered and in tremendous demand once again. Aberdeen Angus steers topped proceedings when a standout pair (19m) from J and K Northcott up from Tideford reached £1770 apiece whist another tidy Angus steer of the same age from Alison Rew of Abbotskerswell sold at £1610 and later born (14m) ones from Martin Reed of Kings Nympton saw a pen of seven rise to £1320 each. British Blue steers next up when a grand single (23m) from AJ Middleton and Sons of Woodbury rose to £1565 closely followed by a strong trio of Blues (22m) just a bid back at £1560 a head For David and Andy Mortimer of Sowton Village. AJ Middleton and Son also saw a giant of a Friesian steer (28m) draw £1550. David Smith and Family back again this week and selling their top quality South Devon bullocks (18m) to £1550 for a super bunch of four whilst a cracking Devon steer (18m) from J and K Northmore came back at a creditable £1540. The latter also sold Hereford steers (17m) to £1410 and a rangy Swiss Brown (18m) for £1300 whilst Limousin bullocks (16m) from Richard Widger and Partners up from Aveton Gifford came back at £1370, a price matched by Andrew Bending of Hittisleigh with his Limousin (26m). An excellent run of South Devon and Charolais crossbred steers (15m) from Jonathan Cuming in from Feniton saw handy bunches to £1195 and £1185. A terrific consignment of very young red Limousin steers from John Jordan and Family of Gidleigh saw their first four in the ring (just 9m) realise a very credible £1100 apiece. Aberdeen Angus stores (18m) also headed the heifer section when racking up a massive £1650 for | and K Northcott with others all born around the same time selling to £1370 for Richard Widger and Partners and £1300 for John and Andrew Ball of Stoke Gabriel. British Blue heifers (22m) followed when fetching £1460 for David and Andy Mortimer and £1400 for Al Middleton and Sons with Simmentals (18m) to £1390 for | and K Northcott again. Limousin females (21m) sold readily and to £1385 for AI Middleton and Son together with others (24m) also making £1385 for RWI Hayman of Blackborough. Also, South Devon heifers (17m) eased to £1100 for John and Andrew Ball again and Herefords (16m) ran to £1070 for | and K Northcott.

Organic Registered Store Cattle

A decent entry for our monthly sale of Organic stores saw a top of £1440 for a super trio of Aberdeen Angus steers (24m) from JLH Vallis and Son of Bradninch whilst a later born pen of Angus steers (18m) drew an impressive £1330 for James Skevington up from Harbertonford and a couple of smart Hereford steers (23m) again from JHL Vallis and Son drew £1220. Ollie Rosewell, Musbury sent in a super run of Red Poll Organic stores and saw his best pair of steers (15m) rise to £1060 apiece whilst an eye catching pen of eight heifers of the same age saw £735 a life.

A yard consisting of all dairy bred stirks met an outstanding trade throughout with many pushing past clients expectations. Hereford steers (11m) topped out at £930 for RM & SJ Middleton in from Woodbury with others pens to £855 and Blue steers to £780. A tremendous run again from Martin & Liz Bennett of Broadhembury saw organic Angus steers (8m) race to £760 with Blues to £750 & £610, whilst Limousin cross steers (6m) attained £725 & £710. Further dairy bred steers saw White & Tucker present Angus steers (7m) which realised £780 with John Ekers up from East Allington presenting Fleckvieh's to £690. JF Reed of Stockleigh Pomeroy saw further Limousin dairy bred steers (9m) reach £675 whilst cracking young Blues from Andrew Barker in from Dunsford (5m) topped out at £660 with others to £640. Heifers topped out at £730 for JF Reed whilst RM & SJ Middleton saw their Blue heifers attain £690. Hereford heifers from RM & SJ Middleton attained £655 whilst Limousin cross dairy breds (9m) from JF Reed reached £610.

CALVES TO 3,000 GS AT EXETER SELECT SALE

Calves from Messrs Wills Bros's noted Willsbro herd topped the prices at the Select Sale at Exeter Livestock Centre which featured youngsters from two leading Cornish herds, Willsbro and the Mitchell Family's Laram herd, as well as a small consignment from the Dulais herd of Welsh breeder Nev Roberts.

Good harvesting weather and the absence of milking stock which have been commanding the best trade in recent weeks reduced the attendance, but there was a healthy demand on Marteye from breeders far afield, including, Scotland, Wales, Cheshire, Cumbria and Lancashire.

Making the top money at 3,000gs was a superbly bred four month old calf from the Rachel Family, sired by Siemers Pfct Hardy and bred from 15 generations of Excellent cows. She was purchased on line by Robert Martin, Carlisle.

Another keenly sought heifer was Willsbro Dynasty Rae 5865 ET, out of an Excellent -94 dam purchased by Messrs Wills for 21,000gs at a Sterndale sale. She made 2,600gs to the Harris Family for their Winkleigh herd.

The Laram consignment sold to 1,900gs 3 times for served heifers, two to Blaise Tomlinson, Leicrestershire and the other to Mark Thomasson, Cheshire. The top Dulais lot was an eight month old calf from the Sharon Family who made 1,600gs to Phil Bird, Axminster,

Biggest volume buyer was Martin Evans Farming Ltd, bidding on Marteye who purchased 35 head for the Priddbwll herd on the Welsh border, while Baltier Farming Co bought 11 animals to go to South West Scotland.

A busy Friday in the sheep pens saw 1683 store lambs and a strong trade from start to finish with a fairly common entry quality wise selling to an average of £100.13 overall, up £4 on the week. Top money of £144.50 to Tony Pickard of North Molton who sold a further penful at £129.50 ahead of Andrew & Miriam Hawkings of Littlehempston at £128.50, AR Henson of Washfield at £126 & £124.50, C Emery of Bridford at £125 and Mike and Janet Folland of Roborough at £123. Short keep lambs usually all £110+ with medium keep lambs £98 to £112 and longer terms sorts looking every bit as dear and normally upwards from £80 with hill lambs also well chased and regularly in the £70's and £80's with only the very small and Shetland crosses less than £57. More lambs required each week please with still some buyers leaving empty handed and many short of requirements, please get in touch if you have some to sell.

50 GRAZING EWES & RAMS

Grazers, like the cull ewes nationally, saw the edge just off with Alice Sharam of Dartmouth topping at £133 ahead of G Drake of Bovey Tracey at £123 and Steve and Michelle Warring of Ashwater at £121. Genuine lean grazers usually £60 to £85 with hill types £30 to £55.

55 BREEDING EWES & 11 STOCK RAMS

A few pens of breeders after Tuesday's sale saw Keith Mitchell of Morchard Bishop reach £162 & £152 with his crossbred shearlings as Marles Farm Services of Farringdon sold his Charollais cross flock aged ewes at £131 & £120 and R Rowe of Saltash sold Lleyns at £120. A super run of shearling rams from John Vanstsone of Tavistock saw his Suffolk's rise to £550 & £520, Berrichons to £420, a pair of much admired BFL x Cheviot Rams at £420 and a Suffolk x Berrichon at £320.

ANNUAL SHOW & SALE OF 209 WHITEFACE DARTMORR FEMALES & 32 RAMS

The annual show and sale of Whiteface Dartmoors saw females rise to £175 for a pair of prizewinning ewe lambs from Clare & Chris Butcher of Manaton who sold a further pen of five at £135 and further pens of ewe lambs at £135 for Arthur & Rosemary Wrayford. Shearlings rose to £140 twice, firstly for an individual from Roy and Ruth Endacott of Spreyton who sold the rest of the pen at £110 whilst Grace Gillard of Drewsteignton sold her pen of 6 well at £140. Older draft ewes at £135 for the Abel Family of Tavistock and £130 and £120 for Phil & Richard Coaker of Postbridge. Crossbred ewes to £115 for FM WFD Mules from Roy Gillard of Drewsteignton.

Rams peaked at 1300gns for the Champion (awaiting confirmation it may be a breed record!), a shearling from Richard & Pete Mann of Widecombe which heads north to Scotland as a new stock ram for Cammy and Lizzie at "Sheep Game" HQ, purchased by Lizzie's mum, Alison Thompson. Next up was Arthur and Rosemary Wrayford at 650gns, Mike Caunter and Family of Harbertonford at 600gns, the Abel Family sold all three of their rams well at 500gns apiece as Roy & Ruth Endacott also claimed 500gns with their aged ram. Seven further rams selling in the four hundreds, only three rams unsold and the 29 sold averaged a very respectable and possibly record breaking £391.




