328 Tractors, Machinery & Effects – Auctioneer: David Kivell & Charlie Kivell


A quieter sale this month influenced by the dry spell of weather had an entry of 328 lots and 63% of lots receiving online bids.

A diverse range of 14 tractors entered with a top call in this section of £19,800 for a 2002 New Holland TS115 with 5,778 hours on the clock. Followed by a 2008 Claas 520 Arion Cebis with a loader and 8,277 hours on the clock to £16,400. The best of the John Deere's topped at £11,900 for a 1995 John Deere 6200 in good working order. £10,800 was achieved for a Massey Ferguson 6170, again in good working order. This was closely followed by £10,500 for a John Deere 6400 with a 40K power quad gearbox.

A 2014 Polaris Ranger with only 578 hours on the clock and 2,386 miles went under the hammer for £4,350, this was closely followed by £4,000 for a 2001 Renault Master lorry having done 109,240 miles and just shy of 12 months MOT.

An impressive lineup of 18 trailers which consisted of a tidy example of a 2018 Ifor Williams TA5 1063 14ft livestock trailer which had been recently serviced and fitted with new brakes which topped out at £3,800. Further trailers achieved £2,900 for a Brian James tilt bed trailer with a winch and £2,600 for a 12ft Ifor Williams tipping trailer.

A strong entry of vehicles once again this month with 16 in the yard and the 2014 VW Golf being the top call in this section with 124, 821 miles on the clock, 11 months MOT and regular service history.
