An impressive range of 26 tractors entered with a top call in this section of £25,400 for a 2009 John Deere 6930 with 11,500 hours on the clock. A Fordson Super Major 5000 from a vintage dispersal topped at £5,200. The 2006 DAF went for £7,400 with 427, 946 miles on the clock but long MOT's on both the tractor unit and the trailer.

An impressive lineup of 18 trailers which consisted of 2 tidy Smyth 18T silage trailers which both went under the hammer for £17,100, followed by £14,500 for a 2014 Richard Larrington 16T silage trailer. A bunning 12T dump trailer topped at £4,200.

Topping this section was £5,000 for the 2014 Ford Ranger with 82,000 miles on the clock and a lengthy MOT, closely followed by £4,800 for a 2015 Isuzu D-Max with 10 months MOT and 116,000 miles on the clock.
